Anti-HLA-G Biotin GRP10607

Description	The antibody 87G recognizes both membrane-bound and soluble forms of HLA-G (HLA-G1 and HLA-G5). HLA-G belongs to the MHC Class I molecules (MHC Class Ib; nonclassical) and it is expressed on the surface of trophoblast cells. The antibody 87G blocks interaction of HLA-G with inhibitory receptors.

Immunogen	HLA-B27 transgenic mice were immunized with H-2 identical murine cells transfected with and expressing genes encoding HLA-G and human beta2-microglobulin.
