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<b>Application Notes</b>	Additional Information: Peptide used to elicit this antibody is not conserved in SOD2,3 and 4. Background: SOD1 [Cu-Zn] (EC=1.15.1.1) is a cytoplasm localized oxidoreductase which destroys radicals normally produced within the cells and toxic to biological systems. Alternative names: SOD, soluble, indophenoloxidase A, Cu/Zn superoxide dismutase, superoxide dismutase, cytosolic Reconstitution: For reconstitution add 50 µl of sterile water.
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
