## Goat anti-Mouse IgG (H&L), ALP conjugated, min. cross-reactivity to human IgG/serum GRP12312

Storage Non-diluted antibody is stable for 4 years at 2-8°C. For storage at

-20°C dilute antibody solution with an equal volume of glycerol to obtain final glycerol concentration of 50 % to prevent loss of enzymatic activity. Such solution will not freeze in -20°C. If you are using a 1:5000 dilution prior to diluting with glycerol, then you would need to use a 1:2500 dilution after adding glycerol. Prepare working dilution prior to use and then discard. Be sure to

mix well but without foaming.

Application Notes Additional Information: This antibody reacts with the heavy chains on mouse IgG

and with the light chains on all mouse immunoglobulins based on immunoelectrophoresis. Minimum cross-reactivity is observed to

non-immunoglobulin mouse serum proteins based on

immunoelectrophoresis. Antibody is supplied in 30 mM triethanolamine, pH 7.2, 5 mM magnesium chloride, 0.1 mM zinc chloride, 1 % (w/v) BSA, Protease/IgG free , 0.05 % (w/v) sodium azide as preservative. Background: Goat anti-mouse IgG (H&L), ALP (alkaline phosphatase) conjugated, is a secondary antibodies which binds to all mouse IgGs in immunological assays. Antibody is adsorbed against

human IgG/serum and affinity purified using solid phase mouse IgG.
