<b>Application Notes</b>	Background: Ubiquitin is a protein that exists in all eukaryotic cells. By conjugation to a large range of target proteins a variety of different modifications can occur. Among other functions, ubiquitin binds to proteins and labels them for destruction. (Originally, ubiquitous immunopoietic polypeptide).
